RESOLUTION #21 WD#10/Public Hearing/CDBG

Passed. **WHEREAS**, the Town of Barre is proposed Water District No. 10; and **WHEREAS**, Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program make funds available to eligible local governments for public infrastructure; and **WHEREAS**, it is the intent of the Town of Barre Board to schedule a public hearing to discuss applying for a CDBG for the Water District 10 Project in the amount of 2,000,000; and **NOW, THEREFORE**, the Town Board of the Town of Barre hereby resolves to hold a public hearing on July 9, 2025 at 7:00 pm at Barre Town Hall to discuss the Water District No. 10 community development needs, specifically the need for certain CDBG applications for the 2025 program year to assist with the Water District 10 project.
